***Rating – Endurance Veterinary Treatment Official**

For appointment to 2* FEI Veterinary Treatment Official

For appointment to 2* FEI Veterinary Treatment Official an applicant will:

- Fulfil the Certification/Registration requirements for practicing veterinarians.
- Have practiced equine veterinary medicine for a minimum of 2 years since graduation/Registration.
- Clinical exposure to Equine Practice must be no less than 25% of total current clinical practice.
- Have been a member of a Veterinary Commission at 3 FEI or National Events and a Treatment Veterinary official at 5 FEI or National Events, 2 of which must be 3* or CEN equivalent as an assistant to the treatment veterinarian.
- Speak one of the two official languages.
- Have qualified at an FEI course for International Endurance Veterinarians.
- Be preferably under the age of 60.

Promotion to 3* FEI Veterinary Treatment Official

For promotion to 3* Official a FEI Endurance Treatment Veterinarian will:

- Have been a 2* Treatment veterinarian at a minimum of 4 events, 1* or 2* level, in any one 2 year period.
- Have been a 2* Treatment Veterinarian for a minimum of two calendar years or two complete seasons.
- Have completed an advanced course, on the diseases of Competition Horses in particular the treatment of endurance horses approved by the FEI Endurance Technical Committee Present to the Endurance Technical Committee a CV with 2 references demonstrating case exposure & skills in the treatment of the disease of Endurance horses.

Promotion to 4* FEI Veterinary Treatment Official

For promotion to 4* Official a FEI Endurance Treatment Veterinarian will:

- Have been a Treatment veterinarian at a minimum of 2 events, 2* level, in any one 3 year period.
- Have been a 3* Treatment Veterinarian at a minimum of 3 events, 3* level, in any one 3 year period.
- Have attended at least one Continuing Education event (seminar/conference) dedicated to Equine Sports Medicine and/or Exercise Physiology, or relevant FEI course, in any one 3 year period.
- Have been a 3* Treatment veterinarian for a minimum of three calendar years.
