ATTENDANCE

- FEI Endurance Stewards or candidates from national federations outside of the US are to email/fax the required FEI paperwork with officiating history listed, and the form signed by the NF, granting permission to attend. This is to be submitted with the course application and copied to the FEI.
- Please fax or mail your completed application form well in advance of the **26 April, 2010 closing date** in order to guarantee a place at the course. You may also register online at www.usef.org by signing in to your 'My USEF Account'.
- A **written exam** will be emailed or faxed to each attendee approximately 2 weeks prior to the course, and must be turned in at the start of the course.
- Attendance sheets must be signed at each session to receive credit for the course. If you arrive more than one hour later than the scheduled starting time, or leave more than one hour earlier than the scheduled adjournment, you will not receive credit for attending the course.
- We will email or fax a confirmation of receipt of your completed application. Online registrations receive immediate confirmation on the web page, no email will be sent.

DIRECTIONS

San Jose Airport to Holiday Inn: Take CA-87 South toward I-280/Downtown for 8 miles, merge onto CA-85 South (Exit 1A) toward Gilroy for 4.2 miles, take exit 1B Bernal Rd toward 101 N and turn left, continue onto Silicon Valley Blvd/Tennant Ave, make a U-turn at Bernal Pl/Eden Park Pl, hotel is on the right.

Holiday Inn to Grant Ranch Park (14 miles): head south on Silicon Valley Blvd, take 101 North for 4.4 miles, exit Capitol Expy E and merge onto Capitol Expy, go 1.4 miles and turn right on Quimby Rd, go 6.8 miles and turn left on Mt. Hamilton Rd/CA-130 W, park is on the left
